DATES: Sunday - Monday, October 9-10, 2011. The first session will convene at 8:30 a.m., Sunday, October 9, 2011. The final session will adjourn at 12:00 p.m., Monday, October 10, 2011.

LOCATION: Mandalay Bay Hotel, Las Vegas (AADB Headquarters Hotel)

GOAL: To provide information and exchange ideas that will aid members in their states. Program highlights are provided on a separate sheet.

HOUSING: A block of rooms has been reserved at the **Mandalay Bay Hotel**. **All room requests for the Las Vegas Session are to be submitted to EXPERIENT, the ADA Housing Bureau. No phone reservations are accepted. There are three ways to register and/or secure hotel reservations – online, mail and fax.** A deposit of \$250 will be due for each hotel reservation. Deposits should be submitted online (credit card only), mailed (credit card or check) or faxed (credit card only) with each reservation to **Experient** for processing.

This block of rooms will be held until July 15, 2011 or until rooms are exhausted. After July 15 or once rooms are exhausted – whichever should occur first - rooms will be assigned on a space available basis at your assigned hotel or at a nearby hotel if space is not available at your assigned hotel. **For this reason, we strongly encourage you to complete and return the reservation form as soon as possible.**

Securing a hotel reservation by mail or fax: Should you wish to register reserve a hotel room utilizing the hard copy form, you may do so by writing the code **AADBLAS** in the top, right corner of the hotel reservation form. **Forms submitted without this code will not be granted access to rooms in the AADB block. The hotel form may be downloaded at ada.org/session.**

Hotel cancellations must be received **in writing** by Experient **before 5:00pm Central Time on Friday, September 16, 2011.** Cancellations received by this date will receive a full refund of the hotel deposit by Experient. Please allow 60 days for refund processing. **Changes to reservations** must be received in writing by Experient **before 5:00pm Central Time on Friday, September 16. Failure to check-in to your hotel on the confirmed date of arrival will result in the forfeiture of the entire room deposit.** As of Wednesday, September 21, 2011 any changes to hotel reservations must be made directly with the hotel. **Hotel deposit refunds will not be issued after September 16.**

AADB MEETING REGISTRATION: A registration form for the **128th AADB Annual Meeting** can be found on our website: dentalboards.org. The registration fee for the meeting is **\$435** for AADB members; **\$585** for nonmembers. This fee is designed to cover costs of meeting materials, the President's Reception for both the registrant and one guest, and the Banquet Luncheon for the registrant only. Guests are welcome at the luncheon but a separate fee is required. Registration is by mail or can be completed online. Go to dentalboards.org and click on the link next to Annual Meeting.

Advance registration is advisable. ***If the AADB Central Office does not receive payment by August 1, 2011 a late fee of \$40 will be applied.*** Payment for the AADB Annual Meeting registration is by check, money order or credit card.

REFUND POLICY: Full refunds of **AADB registrations** will be made to those who notify the Central Office **in writing prior to August 1, 2011**.

Resolutions should be submitted to the Central Office by **June 1, 2011**. Each resolution should be accompanied by a concise background statement. Rationale should appear only in the background statement; the resolution should be limited to the action or proposed statement.
