2. Is your state/territory allowing dental professionals to administer the COVID-19 vaccine to the public?

No, and it is unlikely to change in the future (6): Arizona, Michigan, North Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Wyoming

No, but our state/territory is actively working to allow dental professionals to administer the COVID-19 vaccine in the future (8): District of Columbia, Indiana (legislation proposed for dentists), Minnesota (legislation proposed), Missouri, Nebraska, Nevada, Iowa, West Virginia

Yes (23): Arkansas, California, Colorado, Connecticut (dentists and hygienists), Delaware (mass settings), Georgia, Idaho (dentists and hygienists), Illinois, Kentucky (dentists and hygienists), Louisiana, Maryland (dentists and hygienists under emergency executive order, legislation introduced), Massachusetts (dentists and hygienists have to become an approved COVID-19 vaccinator through the state although Board has defined vaccines in scope of practice), Mississippi (hospitals, public health entities, not private offices), Nevada (dentists and hygienists), New Hampshire, New Jersey, New York (dentists and hygienists), Oklahoma, Ohio (dentists and hygienists), Oregon, Rhode Island (dentists and hygienists), Utah, Virginia (emergency legislation proposed)

Uncertain at this moment but the Dental Board is in favor (1): Alabama

Not at this time (9): Alaska, Colorado, Florida, Georgia, Hawaii, Kansas, South Dakota, Virginia, Washington State

The board will be discussing vaccinations at a future meeting, but a governor's directive would likely be needed (1) Montana

3. We know some states have recently authorized dental professionals to administer the influenza vaccine to the public. Has your state followed suit?

No, and it is unlikely to change in the future (5) Michigan, Mississippi, Rhode Island, Texas, Wyoming

No, but the state board is amenable to dentists administering the influenza vaccine in the near future (7): Arizona, District of Columbia, Idaho, Maryland, Missouri, Nevada, Iowa

No, and we are uncertain about the future (3): Alabama, Hawaii, Washington State

Yes, dentists can administer vaccine (8): Illinois, Louisiana, Massachusetts (dentists and hygienists), Minnesota, Oklahoma, Oregon, West Virginia, Utah

Not at this time (13): Alaska, Colorado, Connecticut, Florida, Georgia, Kansas, Kentucky, New Hampshire, North Dakota, Ohio, South Dakota, Tennessee, Virginia

Legislation may be introduced by the California Dental Association to address this issue (1): California

Not at this time, but the board will be discussing vaccinations at future meetings (1): Montana

4. Is your state/territory allowing dental professionals to conduct COVID-19 testing or order COVID-19 testing?

No, but actively working to allow dental professionals to do this in the near future (5): Alabama, Mississippi, Nevada, New Hampshire, Texas

Not at this time (7): Alaska, Colorado, Kansas, Kentucky, North Dakota, Utah, Virginia
